Football South Australia would like to invite you to the Singa Cup Identification Camp to determine the selection of regional squads that will represent South Australia at the 2024 Singa Cup. This year we are aiming to take four regional squads:

- U14 Boys
- U14 Girls
- U16 Boys
- U16 Girls

The selection process will take place in Adelaide on Friday 26th April where a decision will be communicated to parents/players within two weeks of the selection date. Please see details below:

Date: Friday 26th April

Time: 10:00am – 14:00pm (please arrive at 9:30am to sign players in)

Venue: ServiceFM Stadium, Matilda’s Drive, Gepps Cross

A deposit of \$200 will be required prior to the 23rd April to ensure we can lock teams in for the Singa Cup. If your child is selected, then this deposit will come off the cost of the trip. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Can parents attend?

Parents are welcome to come along to Singapore, Football SA will hold several parent/player meetings before we leave where RAA will be present to discuss travel options for parents

We would like to stay on and have a family holiday after the tournament. Can we get a reduction in costs?

To reduce the costs as much as possible our travel agent is providing a group discount on flights. Due to this group booking we will not be able to offer a reduced fee for players that choose not to arrive or return with the team.

Will there be an opportunity for parents to spend time with players if they were to come along?

This will be dependent on fixtures and game times. We have not yet been provided with this information.

What will players do during time when they are not playing games?

Players will be looked after by Football SA staff for the duration of the trip.

What is the ratio of players to adults/chaperones?

There will be approximately 1 adult to every 6 players. The names of the chaperones attending has not yet been finalised however they will all have appropriate Working With Children Checks.

What are the travel requirements for players?

Players will need to have a valid passport with a minimum of 6 months validity before travel date.

What are the restrictions regarding COVID? Do they need to be vaccinated to enter Singapore?

As at the 13th February 2023 there are no longer requirements to be vaccinated to enter Singapore. As it is a variable situation it is recommended to refer to Singapore Health regulations for up to date information.

Are there any VISA requirements to enter Singapore?

There are currently no requirements to enter Singapore. Please note that Singapore has strict laws and penalties for some acts that are legal or minor offences in Australia including importing or chewing gum. Please see Smartraveller.gov.au for further information.

What are final costings?

We are waiting for confirmation of final numbers before we can finalise the costs. This information will be passed on to the selected players as soon as we have clarification.

What are the payment plans?

The deposit paid for the trial will be deducted from the final cost. We will provide you with further information on payment plans, giving options of payment in full, monthly or fortnightly payments. The expectation is that the fees will be finalised prior to the departure date.
